Music at Laurus Cheadle Hulme

Price of Lessons

A. Year 7 Instrumental Starter Scheme: In groups of 3 or 4

This is a special scheme to encourage year 7 students to learn to play an instrument and get involved in the musical life of the school. Although this is a very enticing price, parents should be aware that there is an expectation that all students enrolling on this scheme will commit to daily practice and will take part the school ensembles and performances. Please note, there are limited places for this scheme and places will go on a first-come-first-served basis.

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 20 minutes £20 in total for the whole year (plus a free instrument, if required)

B. Vocal Coaching Sessions: In groups of 3

We have an exciting course of singing lessons at Laurus Cheadle Hulme, where students receive tuition in groups of 3, delivered by a professional opera/musical theatre vocal coach. Students will work towards a showcase performance and a recording session, later in the year. 1:1 lessons are also available. Please enquire in September about this.

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 20 minutes £45.00 per term

C. 'Create Music' Guitar School: In groups of 3 or 4

A special complete guitar tuition system for beginners, or those already experienced. This package includes a guitar book, CD and a series of certificates to work through. Year 7 students opting for these sessions can borrow a school guitar for the first term for no extra cost, but will need to provide their own instrument from the beginning of the second term.

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 30 minutes (plus a free instrument for the first term, if required)

£60.50 per term

D. Drum Lessons: Individual or paired

Drum lessons are **not** included in our Instrumental Starter Scheme as they do not lend themselves well to group tuition.

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 20 minutes - Paired £92 per term

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 20 minutes – 1:1 £173 per term

E. Piano: Individual

We have 2 private piano tutors who teach across a number of our schools, allowing us to offer special prices for these lessons. The piano is not an instrument that benefits from group tuition and therefore lessons are only offered on a 1:1 basis.

An average of 11 lessons per term @ 20 minutes - 1:1 £110 per term
